ORDER GRANTING SERVICE BY POSTING AND MAILING

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the Plaintiff's Motion for Service by Posting and Mailing pursuant to Alabama Code § 6-6-394.1. Upon consideration of the Motion and the record, the Court finds that service of the notice of garnishment upon the Defendant has not been successfully accomplished and that the requested relief is due to be **GRANTED**.

1. The Clerk of the Court is hereby directed to post:
 - (a) A copy of the notice of garnishment, including the Defendant's right to claim an exemption as provided in Rule 64A of the Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure; and
 - (b) A copy of this Order Granting Service by Posting and Mailing.
2. The Clerk of the Court is further directed to send, by regular U.S. Mail, a copy of the posted notice of garnishment to the Defendant at the Defendant's last known address.
3. The costs associated with this Motion and service shall be taxed to the Defendant.
